Parish Plan September 16 Meeting Report

More than 40 parishioners representing all segments of the parish met last Saturday. Major themes were greater unity across language and income groups, more opportunities for more lay ministers in the liturgy, and more support for marriage and family issues. Common concerns were the poor, the disadvantaged and families separated by deportation. With the help of bilingual participants, several parishioners said that it was the first time they had an in-depth conversation with someone who didn't speak their language. You can still fill out the short questionnaire at the entrance of the church. The next gathering on September 30 will draw on your comments.

Mas de 40 feligreses representando todos los segmentos de la parroquia reunieron el sábado pasado. Los temas claves fueron: más unidad a través de grupos de distintas idiomas y niveles de ingreso, más oportunidades para más ministros laicos de participar en la liturgia, y más apoyo para asuntos matrimoniales y familiares. Preocupaciones comunes fueron los pobres, los perjudicados, y familias separadas por deportación. Con las asistencias de participantes bilingües, varios feligreses dijeron que era la primera vez de conversar a fondo con otra persona que no compartía su idioma.
